

This is the second and last Four Color appearance of Turok before he got his own title.

Many comic books have featured dinosaurs and cave men, but Turok was always the best with spectacular painted covers and atmospheric interior artwork to match. In these early issues "Lost Valley" was called "Sunken

Valley."
