All of these Humorama digest size picture magazines came from a sparkling high grade collection I found in Washington D.C. in October 2010. They belonged to a lady whose parents had collected regular size, oversize and digest size movie and girlie magazines in the 1940s and 1950s. The magazines are exceptionally fresh with white pages and bright glossy covers. Most of them show only minimal handling wear.

Humorama digest size magazines are among the best girlie cartoon magazines. Most of them have cartoons by famous names like Bill Ward, Bill Wenzel and Dan De Carlo. They also have b&w photos of many of the popular pin-up models of the time. Humorama was a divsion of the Martin Goodman publishing empire. Goodman is best known as the publisher of the Timely/Atlas and later even more famous Marvel comic books. He also published most of the Men's Adventure magazines like *Stag* and *For Men Only*. A relative of his, Abe Goodman, ran the Humorama division.
